DRINKING WATER PROBLEM CORRECTED

Customers of Moundsville Water Brd. were notified on 08/5/19 of a problem with our drinking water and were advised to boil all water used for drinking/other activities for 48 hours. We are pleased to report that the problem has been corrected and it is no longer necessary to boil all water used for drinking/other activities for 48 hours. We apologize for any inconvenience and thank you for your patience during this issue.

The areas that are affected are as follows:

- Entire Water System or Eastern Fourth Street affecting only Maxwell Acres and Christy Lynn Drive in Moundsville, WV.

A water shut off was schedule for Tuesday, August 6th, 2019 for Maxwell Acres and Christy Lynn Drive in Moundsville. A construction crew was performing a tie-in on Eastern Fourth Street of a new replacement main water line into the existing main water line. This had affected customers only in the above name areas. The tie-in was completed and water service was returned to all customers in these areas on 8/6/19. The customers affected were notified on 8/5/19 through news media and social media of the scheduled outage and of the boil order. We received word from the lab in Wheeling that the Coliform/Bacti sample has passed. The boil order is LIFTED.
